## Visual arts

- 1 Art on Syros**  
Some 80 works by Istanbul-born painter Marios Prasinos are on display at the 19th-century stone warehouses in Ermoupoli, the port capital of Syros. To September 3.
- 2 Retrospective**  
The Goulandris Museum of Contemporary Art on Andros is hosting a striking retrospective on modern Greek painter Yiannis Moralis, until September 28.
- 3 Sifnos landscapes**  
Landscapes of Sifnos painted by Panayiotis Tetsis can be seen at the Old School in the island's village of Kastro, until August 31.
- 4 Faces of Kythera**  
Panayiotis Fatseas's portraits from a bygone era are on show at the Zeidoron cultural center on the island of Kythera.

## Exhibitions

- 1 Folk music**  
The Greek Parliament Gallery (1 Mitropoleos & Filellinon), is hosting a display of photographs, manuscripts, musical instruments, costumes and recordings dedicated to the folk music traditions of Greece.
- 2 Banknotes**  
The history of Greek banknotes from 1822 to 2002 is the subject of an exhibition at the Greek National Bank Historical Archive (Diomedes Megaron, 146 Tritis Septemvriou). Open Mondays and Tuesdays 10 a.m. - 1 p.m., Wednesdays and Thursdays 5-8 p.m. Admission is free.
- 3 Lesvos**  
See the changes Lesvos has gone through over the years in an exhibition of photographs at the Perama Educational & Sports Center in Geras on the island.



## Theater



- 1 'Birds' revival**  
In celebration of the 100 years since the birth of the acclaimed Greek theater director Karolos Koun, his theater company is reviving one of its most historic productions, Aristophanes' "Birds." The production, which is on tour, will be stopping at Ilis, near Olympia, on August 9.
- 2 Double Oedipus**  
The Greek National Theater premieres its double-bill production of Sophocles' "Oedipus Rex" and "Oedipus at Colonus" at the Ancient Theater of Epidaurus on August 8 and 9, before setting off on a tour of the country that will end in Thessaloniki on September 19. **Page 28**
- 3 Vasiliev's 'Medea'**  
Noted Russian theater director Anatoly Vasiliev is directing Euripides' "Medea" for a production by the Regional Municipal Theater of Patras that is on tour around Greece until September 16. The company will be performing at the Ancient Theater of Dion on August 8.

- 1 Crossover singer** of old-school Greek rock and ballads Socrates Malamas will be at Lake Plastira on August 9 and in Ancient Olympia the following day. **Page 29**
- 2 American-born** bass-baritone Nicholas Isherwood is joined by pianist Maria Aloupi for two concerts of French avant-garde music. The first will be held on August 10 on Tinos and the other on Myconos on August 1.
- 3 Two formidable** Greek voices, Dimitria Galani and Eleftheria Arvanitaki, have taken their combined show on the road this summer and will be performing Greek ballads, classics and other hits at the Siviri Theater in Halkidiki on August 9 and at Santorini's Chateau Wine winery on August 12.
